Belarussian Children Project

For a number of years, PMBA has sponsored children from Belarus. Local families take these children into their homes to become "family" for the six weeks they are in America. While here, they receive medical, dental and eye care that is not available in Belarus. This care is provided free by Baptist Hospital, family dentists, and a local optometrist. The biggest expense is for air travel (round trip) between America and Belarus.

Belarus is the country that received the major contamination from the Chernobyl explosion, and these children are affected by radiation even to this day. The six weeks they are here gives their bodies a rest from the contamination while living in a Christian home. Each child is given a Bible for their own, and every year those coming back for a return visit want Bibles to take back for family and friends.
