- ◇ Remember: all our help is volunteer! Please be courteous and patient while waiting to be served. Please do not complain to our volunteers. Feel free to say “thank you” for the service they are providing.
- ◇ We can always use more volunteers in the kitchen area. Some of our volunteers are leaving their regular day jobs to go to the church and cook and/or serve meals. If you have free time during the day, we can certainly use your help! Call Trudy Elkins if you are willing to help.
