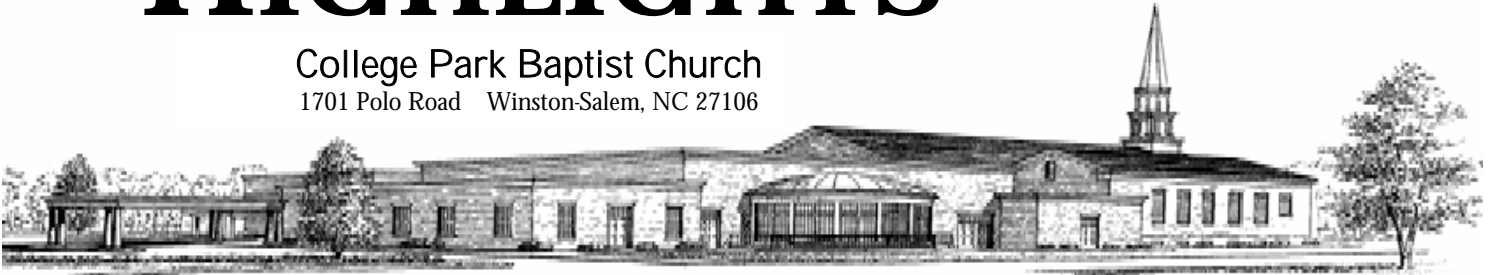

2007 Mission Giving Report

Thanks to your financial commitment and support of the Budget Ministries of College Park Baptist Church, we were able to pay out more than 100% of our budgeted missions in 2007...a total of \$159,545.20. In addition to budgeted missions, you also gave \$95,694.03 to special designated missions.

Total missions paid out in 2007 was \$256,148.00. This represents 29% of the total dollars received for all budget and special offerings. As you can see, College Park continues to give high priority to local, state, national, and church missions.
