**Now, do you think God may have you in mind for these positions? Let us all make the commitment to show our faith through our serving!! Amen!**

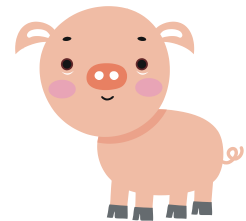
## ***Squeal on a Singer***

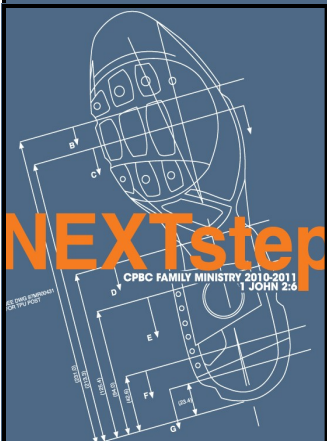
