THE POWER OF A SIMPLE ENVELOPE OUR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH ARE HEADED TO BELIZE IN 2016



This year, our high school youth will participate in a meaningful service opportunity in Belize. Located in Central America and the heart of Mayan civilization, the country of Belize features diverse geography, gorgeous scenery and cultural diversity. It's a beautiful English-speaking country, which makes ministering there easier for our group. Praying Pelican Missions, who organized our trip to Jamaica, will be helping to make this mission trip happen.

A question we often hear is how will we pay for a trip like this. Any trip like this can be expensive for our people. Fundraising has been a considerable part of our past mission efforts. We have done Dinner and a Shows, BBQ sales, yard sales, and the like. In making financial preparations for this trip, we want to try something a little different. This effort is called "144 Envelopes." Here is how it works...

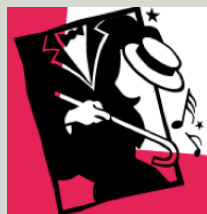
From November 1 through November 15, the team will host a table outside of Smith Hall. On this table will be 144 envelopes. The outside of each envelope will have a dollar amount printed on it - \$1, \$2,

\$3 and so forth all the way to \$144. Inside each envelope will be a letter from one of the youth members talking about the upcoming trip.

Here is how you can help:

- Choose an envelope with the preferred donation amount
- Open the envelope and replace the participant letter with the suggested donation
- Place the envelope with donation in the slot at the Giving Kiosk or pay for the donation by debit/credit card at the Giving Kiosk
- Take the participant letter home and use it as a reminder to pray for the trip

We know that everyone will be praying and encouraging us as we prepare. If you are able to give at any level, our team is thankful for your generosity and trust. We will strive to represent Christ with honor as we take all the blessings from College Park and use them to share His love. We thank you!

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD IS HERE!

Our children and youth mission groups are working together on this year's Operation Christmas Child, a ministry effort to share the joy of Christmas with children around the world. Our children and youth will be making gift boxes on Wednesday, November 18. We need donated items to go in the boxes.

These donations (suggested list below direct from a missionary) will be collected during the weeks leading up to November 18. Donation boxes are in the hallway outside Smith Hall.

- For any age boy here, what they really want is a soccer ball. So get the best quality mini soccer ball that you can fit into the box when it is inflated (or send a deflated ball with a pump) and you can basically forget about anything else! :)
- Brand new nice short-sleeved shirts (with no writing on them) for boys and girls. Kids have few clothes and often wear old, ripped, hand-me-downs.
- Small flashlight with batteries (Most families don't have electricity so a working flashlight is gold!)
- Good quality melamine plate, bowl, and/or cup.

- Soap AND a plastic soap dish that has a cover.
- Toothbrush in a toothbrush holder.
- Pencils, erasers, colored pencils, and sharpeners for all school-aged kids. And good quality pens for kids aged 10-14, in black, red, green, and blue.
- Jump ropes
- Marbles
- Harmonica
- Band-Aids
- Hard candy and gum
- Comb
- Hair elastics or headbands for girls
- A simple watch for older kids
- A solar calculator for older kids
- Sunglasses for older kids
- Socks
- For the youngest girls, a baby doll with light brown skin and no hair
- Toy car, truck or airplane for the youngest boys (The ones with bigger wheels that are made for toddlers and are larger than Matchbox size are good. Matchbox wheels are so small, they don't work well in dirt.)
