# A NOTE FROM MARY



A couple of days ago Rebecca and I were heading into the house, when I heard, "Look, Mom! A deer!" Looking around, I realized it was not one deer, but six. Deer in our cul-de-sac are not that uncommon, but these were exceptionally close, right next door. I whispered to Rebecca to be really quiet and really still, and we just sat and watched. In turn, the deer watched us, measuring whether we were a threat or not. Seconds turned into moments, and we just sat. All of a sudden, one of the deer started to come closer.
