RAMON'S UPDATES

Our new Bible Study Class had 13 people Sunday morning! This is a great start, and we are excited about the prospects for even more new classes getting started in our Sunday School!

As I've written the last couple of weeks, we have a wonderful opportunity during the weeks preceding Easter to really reach out to those who are unchurched and lost. This Sunday I will be sharing more information about a new emphasis leading up to Easter entitled "Reach Ten for Him." It is designed to be a follow-up to our "He Did This Just for You" emphasis. The process works like this...

1. Think of ten friends/neighbors/work associates who need to hear the gospel.

2. Give them a copy of the "He Did This Just for You" booklet OR the "He Did This Just for You" special edition New Testament with reflections from Max Lucado, and 30-Day New Believers Studies, and write their names on a Ten for Him card (available from Ramon) or index card.

3. Commit to pray for these people daily and encourage them to attend church (with you if possible) this Easter Sunday (if not before)!

We still have a limited number of the "He Did This Just for You" booklets and a good supply of the special edition New Testaments in the church office. The booklets are only \$1, and the New Testaments are only \$4. Please prayerfully consider how God can use you this Lent season as we prepare for Easter. Although it is designed to include ten people, certainly you may opt to concentrate on a smaller group of people.

The True Love Waits Rally on Wednesday, February 13th was a huge success. There were over 1300 young people in attendance, and over 200 young people made decisions for Christ, with many first-time professions of faith! Thanks for your prayers!

Jeff's Notes

As Dr. Baucom explained in the newsletter last week and on Sunday, we are now in the season of Lent. This is a time set aside to look inward to allow God to cleanse us of those things that form barriers in our relationship with him. This period of six weeks comes just prior to Easter so that we can be better prepared to accept and celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. An important final part of Lent is the special services of Holy Week (the week just prior to Easter, beginning with Palm Sunday). These services are vital to embracing the reality of the events in Jesus' life which culminated with his crucifixion. This year we will be having three Holy Week services. The first will be a music service on Sunday evening, March 2, led by Channels. The second will be our Maundy Thursday service on March 28, led by Ainesis and Dr. Baucom. The final Holy Week service will be our traditional Tenebrae service on Good Friday, led by the Sanctuary Choir. Please plan now to make all of these a part of your preparation.

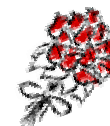
