A new federal law greatly restricts the disclosure of patient information by hospitals. If you are hospitalized and would like to notify the church, it is important that you or a family member call us (768-5870) as soon as possible. Remember, hospitals no longer can provide this information to us.

College Park compiles a prayer list that contains names of persons who are known to be hospitalized or ill. If you do not want your name and/or medical condition published on the church prayer list, you must inform the church office.
