I had the opportunity this past Friday evening, along with our chair of Deacons, to represent College Park in attending the opening service of the NC Baptist Forum held at FBC, Greensboro. This was an organized gathering of moderate NC Baptists concerned about the trends that have developed in our state convention. The group met, not for the promotion of some alternate agenda, but to find support among each other in our concerns and to seek God's guidance as this entire group, as well as individual churches, discern direction for the future. I was inspired through the experience in two ways: first, through the genuine sense of worship that prevailed during most of this opening session; and, second, in that this group of moderate Baptists are willing to corporately say "we don't know..." where we should head, but we are certain that God will direct us. This is the essence of faith. This is the scriptural model set for us (I Cor. 13:9). I trust College Park will be a faithful part of this process.
