Dear Friends and Family,

My daughter, Julia Walls Kiefer, was diagnosed this summer with non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma and Multiple Myeloma. She has been undergoing chemo treatments at Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem, N.C. After this portion of the treatment was completed, she was transferred to Duke Medical Center's ABMT Clinic for a peripheral blood stem cell (PBSC) transplant. She was fortunate to be able to donate her own stem cells for this transplant. The next part of her treatment will occur in three months when she will require what they are referring to as a mini-transplant. She will need stem cell material from a donor other than herself. Julie's sister was not found to be a viable candidate, so our family has come together alongside Division 5 Carolinas District of Kiwanis International to have a marrow donor drive for the National Bone Marrow Registry. This drive will provide The Marrow Foundation with new prospective donors for not only Julia but others who might need marrow or stem cells for their treatment. The requirements of a donor are the following:

- You must be between the ages of 18 and 60
- You must be willing to donate to any patient in need
- You must meet the health guidelines
- You must be willing to answer health questions at the time of registration
- You must be willing to have the inside of your cheek swabbed for cell samples

The cost of being a member of the registry is \$52 per person. If at any point an individual decides he/she does not want to be a donor, then they may remove their name from the registry.

If you do not match the requirements to be a donor, please consider a financial contribution to defer the cost for those who are interested in registry membership. Every donation, large or small, will be most appreciated. All financial donations are tax deductible. Checks should be made payable to: The Marrow Foundation.
