In the second poorest county in Kentucky, Mountain Outreach began as a concern among Cumberland College students for the poverty and desperation they saw so close about them. Initially focusing on home repairs and renovations during weekends and holidays, the ministry progressed to sponsor church mission work teams. Now under the direction of new Executive Director Marc Hensley, Mountain Outreach involves mission work teams from a number of states, working to build complete homes for needy families, giving them *a warm, dry place to live*.

University of the Cumberlands is proud of its liberal arts curriculum. Mountain Outreach is a wonderful outreach tool for this small but significant university.
