## *From Your Pastor...*

We are entering the last two weeks of our journey to the cross. As we prepare for Holy Week, let me challenge you to be a part of the whole week. Yes, I know that there is a lot going on...we all feel that stress...but this is an important time for us as a church. As we meet this Sunday for Palm Sunday, we can hear the cries of the crowd, "Hosanna!" But something changed during the course of that week over two thousand years ago, and the cries of "Hosanna" became cries of "Crucify him!" Our journey during Holy Week will take us on several stops: 1) Palm Sunday, when we will worship the majesty of the King of Kings; 2) Maundy Thursday, when we will examine the new Maundy (from the Latin word from which we derive the word "mandate"); 3) Tenebrae service on Good Friday, when we hear Jesus say, "It is finished."; 4) *"The Passion Rock Opera"* on Saturday night, when we will experience the significance of Holy Week as expressed by the music of Third Day and presented by APB; 5) Easter Sunday, when we will gather together to exalt our risen Savior!

All of these services work together to tell a story that all of creation needs to hear...and that is where we must serve as the messengers! One suggestion: due to the nature of *"The Passion Rock Opera,"* it may be a better choice for someone not raised in church. The message will be presented by music, and the listener will come face to face with the reality of Jesus' life, death and resurrection. Pray that God will use you to spread the "Good News!"
