## From Your Pastor...

This past Sunday we talked about Jesus visiting His disciples following the Resurrection, about how He demonstrated that He is faithful, and that the promises He makes...He keeps! We also recognized that just as those early disciples needed the power of the Holy Spirit in order to live a Godly life...so do we! A life that is truly Spirit-led will not look the life of this world. It will not be a life that is guided by fear of the unknown, rather claiming the power of what is truly known! As we discussed in the **30-Day Church Challenge** last fall, the first century church had its challenges, but they also knew full well that the answer to their challenges resided in the Holy Spirit which *was sent to make them one!* As a result of their reliance on the Holy Spirit, they were led to the following purposes as a body:

### Five Purposes...One body!

- 1) Authentic Community
- 2) Genuine Worship
- 3) Spiritual Growth
- 4) Faithful Stewardship
- 5) Intentional Outreach

*(Acts 2:42-47)*

And despite the temptation to do so, I do

not believe these purposes can be wrapped up and marketed as “church growth,” because we cannot grow the church...God does that! Our call is to BE the church, and God has sent His Spirit to enable us to do that. My challenge: Go back and read the Acts passage referenced above, and pray that God will continue to transform you/us as we seek to serve Him more perfectly!

Sunday, April 21st is **Youth Sunday** here at College Park! I want to challenge each of us to be in prayer for our young people and leaders as they make final preparations to lead in this worship service.

Sunday, May 5th is the service we commonly refer to as “Music Day” (**In Praise of God** is the real “title”). We also need to pray for our choirs and leadership as they prepare for this day of worship. As I have openly acknowledged, a song can often speak more clearly than any spoken word!

## A NOTE FROM MARY



I have received a lot of comments and compliments about this year's Tenebrae worship. It was a powerful and meaningful experience for all of us who were involved in leading that night, and we are thankful that God used our offerings to draw others to Him. I read an interesting article this morning by a well-known worship leader who talked about those "times when God's presence moves among us in an intensely intimate reverence as undone hearts encounter the glory of God." Last Friday was one of those times. The article goes on to talk about how those times are somewhat occasional in our congregational worship. However, the question was posed, "Do we come expecting those encounters?" And I wonder: do we? Do we come to worship expecting to experience the presence of God? Often we come with expectations: fellowship, updates on those we care about, beautiful music, a meaningful message. All of these things are good; however, knowing that God is present in our corporate worship, are our expectations of worship enough? Have we come with anticipation, prepared to meet a living God? In my own life, I can say that there are times when I come with that expectation and others when I do not. However, I have found that when I come anticipating meeting God in worship, He never fails to show up...not always in the way expected, but He speaks nevertheless. My prayer for coming weeks is that I will walk in the building each week expecting God to move in our corporate worship. I hope you will join me in praying the same.
