## SUMMER MISSION TRIP ANNOUNCED OUR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH ARE HEADED TO BELIZE IN 2016

This year, our high school youth will participate in a meaningful service opportunity in Belize. Located in Central America and the heart of Mayan civilization, the country of Belize features diverse geography, gorgeous scenery and cultural diversity. It's a beautiful English-speaking country, which makes ministering there easier for our group. Praying Pelican Missions, who organized our trip to Jamaica, will be helping making this mission trip happen.

This Belize missions trip will offer our group opportunities to serve in orphanages, speak in churches, work in construction, play on sports fields or assist in schools. Everyone will use their talents to make a difference.

Our high school mission team will be put together over the next few months. As we prepare spiritually, we will spend a significant amount of our efforts in raising money. We will have two fundraising opportunities over the coming months. Please begin praying for the team and these fundraising efforts.

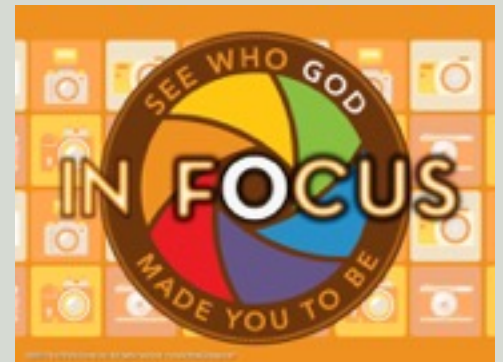

## YOUTH HEADED TO 2ND HARVEST FOOD BANK

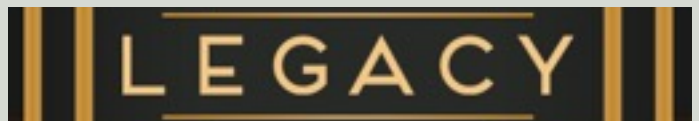
OCTOBER 10 ~ 8 AM - 1:00 PM
