Refugees who have been placed in the United States because they had to flee their homes (more than half are under the age of 18), have left behind their entire way of life and face the daily realities of uncertainty and distress.

We serve a God who desires a relationship with displaced people. As Christians, and as members of College Park, we are uniquely positioned to minister to refugees. Our compassionate response to the physical and emotional needs of refugees must be coupled with a desire to satisfy their spiritual needs through the hope found in Jesus Christ.

During the evening of Wednesday, March 11, we will have the opportunity to participate in a simulation to develop a greater understanding about the issues refugees face and to learn what the Bible teaches about our Christian response to refugees. Plan to join the experience on March 11.

At the January church conference, the Deacons shared for information purposes a motion that will be presented for a vote at the April conference. The motion reads as outlined below. No language from this section is removed or changed. The sentence in italics and underlined will be added.

The Deacons move that the underlined language be added to the Constitution:

ARTICLE X, COMMITTEES AND COUNCILS, Section 1, Committees. The church shall have such committees as designated by its members from time to time. The chair and members of the committees shall be elected by members of the church upon recommendation by the Enlistment Committee. *Committee membership is restricted to church members and to non-members who have demonstrated engagement in the life of the church. The Deacons shall maintain a list of committees whose membership is restricted to church members.* The committees shall have such duties as are assigned to them by the church....
