# A NOTE FROM MARY



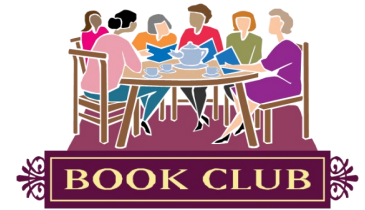
God Who Hears

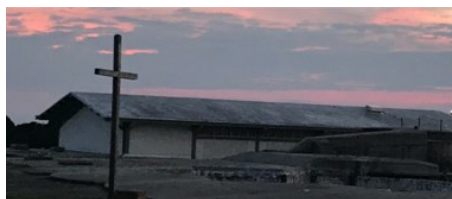
