

August 1 is an interesting day in history: William Carey was ordained into the ministry on August 1, 1787; Francis Scott Key, Christian attorney, statesman, Sunday School teacher, and the author of the American national anthem, was born on August 1, 1779; August 1, 1808, marks the birth of Octavius Winslow, powerful nineteenth century pastor and author; August 1, 1834 marks the death of Robert Morrison, 52, first protestant missionary to China; and on August 1, 1834, slavery was abolished throughout the British Empire, largely as a result of tireless abolitionist efforts of British evangelicals! As I pondered these events, it occurred to me that as Christians we have a tremendous responsibility to impact our world in a godly fashion. We live in a time when material blessings are in excess, yet our culture seems to be deteriorating...perhaps there is a cause and effect relationship there! As Christians, we must go back to the basics of making the things of God a priority, and that is the focus of worship this Sunday morning. If you would like a "head-start" on the learning curve, you can read Haggai (it's only two short chapters) before coming Sunday.
