## Covenant with New Believers

*Minister:* Do you believe in God the Father?

***Congregation:* I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of Heaven and earth.**

*Minister:* Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

***Congregation:* I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.**

*Minister:* Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

***Congregation:* I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Christian church, The communion of the saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.**

*Minister:* Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers for each other and these new believers?

***Congregation:* I will, with God's help.**

*Minister:* Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?

***Congregation:* I will, with God's help.**

*Minister:* Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ, and be faithful to pray for those who are lost?

***Congregation:* I will, with God's help.**

*Minister:* Will you seek and serve Christ by ministering to all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

***Congregation:* I will, with God's help.**

*Minister:* Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

***Congregation:* I will, with God's help.**

***All:* These things we covenant together before God. Amen.**
