Covenant with New Believers

Minister: Do you believe in God the Father?

Congregation: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Minister: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

Congregation: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.
