
A World From Wil



FOR YOUR INFORMATION ... PART 4:

Have you heard about ... THE GREEN SHEET?

In the process of working with families who have lost loved ones, we often find that the family does not know what the wishes of the deceased were regarding funeral plans. The family may know favorite scripture verses or hymns, but often times there have been no conversations about other wishes surrounding end-of-life issues.

We encourage each of you to talk with your children/family and let them know what your specific wishes are concerning the legal and memorial issues that your families will face when you leave to be with the Father. If you will take a few minutes and write these things down, then it will make things much less stressful for your loved ones at a time when they will be grieving and stressed already. One document that will be very helpful for them is the "green sheet." Some of you have already filled out one of these, and if so, we have it on file in the church office. These are very helpful in planning memorial services and funerals, so we ask that each adult take a few minutes and fill one out and then drop it by the church office or mail it to us. These may be updated at any time simply by calling the church office.

Please call if you have questions, but please take the time to help us help your family.
